

- 16.4 WHEREAS, North Bellmore Union Free School District (the "School District") requested sealed bids for the capital improvement project entitled "2020 Security Vestibule Installation" at Saw Mill Road Elementary School and John G. Dinkelmeyer Elementary School, SED Nos. 28-02-04-02-0-005-032 and 28-02-04-04-0-006-029, respectively ("Contract No. 1");

WHEREAS, the School District received and opened bid proposals for the provision of labor and materials for Contract No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the School District's Architect, John A. Grillo Architect P.C., reviewed and evaluated said bid; and

WHEREAS, based upon the aforesaid review and evaluation of the submitted bid proposals, the District Administration recommends that the Board of Education award Contract No. 1 to Preferred Construction, Inc. ("Preferred") as the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined that the best interests of the School District are promoted by award of Contract No. 1 to Preferred.

NOW THEREFORE, BE FURTHER IT RESOLVED that upon the recommendation of the District Administration, the Board of Education awards Contract No. 1 to Preferred Construction, Inc. in the sum of \$290,000.00. (See attached.)
